

JULIAN'S MITERED SCARF

YARN and NEEDLES: any yarn weight with needles one size larger than recommended
Sock weight with Size US 3 (3mm); Sport weight yarn on US 5 (3.75mm),
DK weight with US 7 (4.5mm), or Knitting Worsted weight yarn with US 9 (5.5mm).

NOTIONS: tapestry needle

ONE-COLOR JULIAN'S MITERED SCARF - Pattern Notes

S2KP - Central Double decrease: slip 2 stitches together as if to knit them together, k1, p2sso; <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WJhiJZ2pdK8>

Cable Cast On Plus:

- 1.) When casting on during the knitting process, turn the knitting as if you were going to work the next row but rather cast on.
- 2.) Cast on one stitch using the knitted cast and then use the cable cast on for the remaining stitches.
- 3.) Turn and work the row in the established pattern just for the cast on stitches . . .
- 4.) The next stitch looks different; k1-tbl (Knit this stitch through the back loop to tighten it) and then proceed with established pattern

DIRECTIONS: JULIAN'S MITERED SCARF IS A 20-ROW PATTERN.

Cast on 29 stitches and work this WS row once: k11, p1, k17

Row 1 (RS): k16, S2KP, k10; 27 sts.

Row 2 (WS): k10, p1, k16

Row 3: k15, S2KP, k9; 25 sts;

Row 4: k9, p1, k15

Row 5: k14, S2KP, k8; 23 sts

Row 6: k8, p1, k14

Row 7: k13, S2KP, k7; 21 sts

Row 8: k7, p1, k13

Row 9: k12, S2KP, k6; 19 sts

Row 10: k6, p1, k12

Row 11: k11, S2KP, k5; 17 sts

Row 12: k5, p1, k11

Row 13: k10, S2KP, k4; 15 sts

Row 14: k4, p1, k10

Row 15: k9, S2KP, k3; 13 sts

Row 16: k3, p1, k9

Row 17: k8, S2KP, k2; 11 sts

Row 18: k2, p1, k8

Row 19: k7, S2KP, k1; 9 sts. TURN but do not knit Row 20 yet; Cable Cast On Plus 10 sts; 19 sts on needle and work Row 20

Row 20 (WS): k10, k1-tbl, p1, k7; TURN but do not knit Row 1 yet; Cable Cast On Plus 10 sts; 29 sts on needle and Repeat Rows 1 to 20 for pattern.

Last Miter: Repeat Rows 1 to 19

Last Row 20: Bind off. Weave in ends.



JULIAN'S MITERED SCARF - A STROKE OF COLOR

MATERIALS: MC (Main Color) amounts same as above plus 15 yards of a CC (contrast color)

SLIP-2 - slip two stitches as if to k2tog

p2sso - pass 2 slipped stitches over the just knitted stitch

Color cross the colors on every row: work all the stitches you need in the first color. Drop the old strand and bring the new color up from underneath the old one. This twists the strands together, preventing holes from forming; then position the yarn in the back between the needles to knit the next stitch.

Cable Cast On Plus:

- 1.) When casting on during the knitting process, turn the knitting as if you were going to work the next row but rather cast on.
- 2.) Cast on one stitch using the knitted cast and then use the cable cast on for the remaining stitches.
- 3.) Turn and work the row in the established pattern just for the cast on stitches . . .
- 4.) The next stitch looks different; k1-tbl (Knit this stitch through the back loop to tighten it) and then proceed with established pattern

DIRECTIONS: JULIAN'S MITERED SCARF - A STROKE OF COLOR

Cast on 29 stitches and work this WS row once: k11, p1, k17

Row 1 (RS): MC-k16, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k10; 27 sts

Row 2 (WS): MC-k10, CC-p1, MC-k16

Row 3: MC-k15, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k9; 25 sts

Row 5: MC-k14, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k8; 23 sts

Row 7: MC-k13, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso MC-k7; 21 sts

Row 9: MC-k12, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k6; 19 sts

Row 11: MC-k11, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k5; 17 sts

Row 13: MC-k10, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k4; 15 sts

Row 15: MC-k9, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k3; 13 sts

Row 17: MC-k8, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k2; 11 sts

Row 19: MC-k7, SLIP-2, CC-k1, p2sso, MC-k1; 9 sts.

Row 4: MC-k9, CC-p1, MC-k15

Row 6: MC-k8, CC-p1, MC-k14

Row 8: MC-7, CC-p1, MC-k13

Row 10: MC-6, CC-p1, MC-k12

Row 12: MC-5, CC-p1, MC-k11

Row 14: MC-4, CC-p1, MC-k10

Row 16: MC-3, CC-p1, MC-k9

Row 18: MC-2, CC-p1, MC-k8

TURN but do not knit Row 20 yet;

With MC, Cable Cast On Plus 10 sts; 19 sts on needle and work Row 20

Row 20 (WS): MC-k10, MC-k1-tbl, CC-p1, MC-k7; 19 sts. TURN but do not knit Row 1 yet;

With MC, Cable Cast On Plus 10 sts; 29 sts on needle and Repeat Rows 1 to 20 for pattern.

Last Miter: Repeat Rows 1 to 19

Last Row 20: Bind off. Weave in ends.
