Sharing from March Meeting:



Linda Erlich knitted a rectangular "Wrap Me Up" shawl, in multicolor yarns by Knit One Crochet Too Paintbox and Cascade 220.

Eileen Adler made a cardigan, her original pattern, in rainbow colors of Cascade Nikki. The back is knitted vertically, while the sides are picked up at the side edge and worked horizontally. To maximize yardage, a dropped stitch is used in



the sleeves. The neckline is trimmed in a loop stitch, and there is a knitted carnation flower as an adornment.



MaryAnn Archibald made a vest (Red Heart pattern), a scarf (her pattern) and a purse (also her pattern). The vest is called "Upside Down", the scarf is a fake mobius and the purse is a Camellia Flower bag. Colorway- reds; yarn- Aura cashmere. Thea Lazarevic knitted Elsebeth Lavold's "Viking Turid" pattern, a long-sleeved tunic from Knitter's, Fall 2000. The colorway is gray; the yarn is 100% cotton, knitted on size 5 and 6 needles.



Cia Bullemer made a vest

from Creative Knitting, Sept. 2010. The yarn is Plymouth's Mushishi. The vest features good

Dorrit Franke made a jacket of her own design, of Blue Sky 100% wool. The colorways are orange, cyclamen and plum. The front and back are felted, cut into pattern for front and back panels; the sleeves are set-in, and the border is made with picked up stitches.





Jackie Kuhn knitted a cardigan, "Tempest", in two different Noro Kureyon sock yarns. Jackie also made a gathered pullover in Green Mountain's Spinnery Sylvan Spirit yarn, silver.

She added a twisted rib to the bottom of the sweater and sleeves to prevent the stockinette from rolling.

Dee-dee Drewrey knitted "Linen Wrap" in autumn colors of Silky Wool by Elsebeth Lavold. The pattern by Sally Melville is in her book, <u>Colors</u>.





Connie Horst made wool socks for her husband in Nancy Muschek's MTM sock class. Great!

Colleen Davis made an original freeform cardigan of blue and olive yarns from her stash. The pattern tumbles unmitered rectangles sideways, upside down and around.





Barbara Levin knitted Stephen West's "Chadwick" scarf/ shawlette in grey and light blue Madeline Tosh Pashmina and Miss Babs Windsor yarns. Josephine Needleman Barkhousen knitted a circular shrug from a Vogue pattern in green and purple variegated Art Yarn.
