David Davies- A Simpler Time, Alpaca Ranch

David Davies, from A Simpler Time Alpaca Ranch, will present a program on production of alpaca yarn, from raising the

animals to the spinning process.

It is a small alpaca ranch, 30 minutes east of San Diego. They offer alpacas, alpaca sweaters, scarves, mitts, teddy bears and more, and operate a full service mill, turning fiber into yarn, roving, batts or felt sheets. In addition to computerized spinning, they are Schacht spindle dealers for all hand spinners.

Cia Bullemer, our personal connection with Plymouth Yarns as their new Director of Design, knitted an original jumper in pink superwash merino that was kettle dyed.




Pauline Bushey knitted a hat and fingerless gloves with a Trendsetter kit and DK yarn.

Mary Brown made a shawl of Twisted Sisters lace weight wool, employing a combination of charted patterns from <u>Crazy Lace</u> by Myra Wood.





Nancy Woodhove knitted a Belle Nuit shawl in Madelinetosh sock yarn, and a pair of Monkey Socks of SweetGeorgia Tough Love Sock yarn in "Riptide".







Chris Ward joined Helene in knitting a Berroco "Drift" cardigan, but used Berroco's Vintage yarn. The Norah Gaughan pattern is free on Ravelry.

Eileen Adler knitted this sweater of her own design on a knitting machine, using two colorways of Noro yarn, about 1600 yards total, on size US 6 needles. The name of the garment is "Been Found" because it can be worn several ways- you just



have to find one! Eileen's knitting machine is a KnitKing 230-bulky and has 110 needles. She knitted it from side-to-side in two pieces to highlight the stripes vertically. The sleeves are knitted separately from the armhole edge to the cuffs. All finishing details are hand knitted.
