## USING THE HELPFUL TABLE IN STEP 6 INCREASING FOR SLEEVE CAP, FRONT NECK, AND BODY

Everything you need to knit a Ziggurat sweater is written out in the pattern instructions.

The Helpful Table is provided only for extra convenience, to be helpful! I created it as a visual aid for my own design process and it became a trademark feature of all Ziggurat patterns from the start.

The Helpful Table can be your good friend, especially if you wish to modify a Ziggurat pattern. Or design your own. But also just for carefree knitting.

The stitch counts in the squares reflect the total after completing a particular row (or round, when working in the round).

When working flat:

- Odd rows = RS
- Even rows = WS






Most increases take place on RS/odd rows.

Sleeve Cap faux seam stitch is slipped only on RS/even rows.

Most WS/odd rows are plainly purled (blank squares).

All Helpful Tables are colour coded the same way, which is also reflected in the written instructions.

- Red squares and red font: **Sleeve increases** sm1
- Green squares and green font: **Neck increases** nM1
- Blue squares and blue font: **Body increases** bM1
- Yellow squares: **Front cast on**
- Orange squares: **Underarm cast on**
- Pink squares and pink font: **Buttonholes**
